Information

Run:

There have been a few problems with the track and other venues for the run meaning that we are forced to hold this year's event on road. The course we are using is almost traffic free with no road crossings. Please be aware of pedestrians and be as safe as possible! To reduce the numbers of runners on the roads and pavements at any one time there will be a staggered start based on run your competitor number. Two competitors will start every 30 seconds from 14.30 onwards. Start times will be displayed in several locations on the day and the organizers will shout lots. If you're in the area of the start for the right time you won't miss it! Please be as helpful as you can as it's going to be busy.

Run course: Map 1

The course is 3000m out and back (1500m each way).

From the start you will head out along meadow lane to the end. Turn right as indicated by the marshal and run along the pavement until you reach the turn around point. Then back the way you came.

Feel free to warm up on the course but keep out of the way of those racing.

The course will be well marshaled, please do as instructed by the marshals they will be looking out for your safety.

Swim heats:

The swim heats in the program are as accurate as of Thursday 2nd March. There may be alterations so please check your heat on the heat lists poolside.

The Rules

The competition will be run in accordance with the 2004 UIPM Competition rules with MPAGB amendments and additional rules regulating the scoring of the team pentathlon. This document is not in any way considered to be a rulebook for the competition.

Jury of Appeal

In the event of a dispute in either the pentathlon or biathlon, the Jury of Appeal will consist of Tom Kennedy, Ben Measures, Aly Rowell and the officer in charge of the event concerned. The jury will hear reasonable argument and then shall make a fair decision according to the rules. The jury's decision is final.

Team Rules

Pentathlon teams consist of three athletes of either sex each of whom must **contest** four events. Should an athlete not start all four events for any reason, the team will not be eligible. In addition, each of the five events must be contested by at least one member of the team. The team score is the sum of the best four scores of each individual **regardless of the events in which those scores were obtained.** Biathlon teams consist of three athletes of the same sex: the team score is calculated as the total of the three individual scores. All Pentathlon teams must be declared before the start of the ride event at registration on Friday evening. Similarly all Biathlon teams must be declared before the start of the run event at registration on Saturday afternoon.

Ride I/C Oliver Rees-Jones (in the event of a dispute, Ben Measures will join the Jury of Appeal)

The ride will be a show jumping course (3ft) on an unfamiliar horse allocated by ballot. You will have 15mins on your horse in the collecting arena, during which time you may make no more than 4 practice jumps. You must make sure you jump in the correct direction.

Fence I/C Ben Candy

Depending on numbers, the men's and women's fence may each be split into two seeded pools. Pool lists will be published at 0830 on Saturday in the Sports Centre.

Shoot I/C Simon Glasscock

Confirmed shoot details will be published at the ride on Friday night. Men in the first detail must make sure to arrive promptly on Saturday morning.

Points 1000=172+/- 12 per target point

Run I/C Ed Donati (in the event of a dispute, the jury of appeal will be joined by Tom Kenady)

The run 3000m out and back course. Trainers/ road racers will be appropriate.

Points Men 1000=10m00s +/- 4 points per 1 second
Women 1000=11m20s +/- 4 points per 1 second

Swim I/C Simon Glasscock

200m freestyle swim for men and women (8 lengths of the pool)

Points Men 1000=2m30s +/- 6 points per ½ second
Women 1000=2m40s +/- 6 points per ½ second

BUSA Medals are awarded to the top three individuals in the Pentathlon and Biathlon (Male and Female), and the top three teams in the Biathlon (Male and Female) and the Pentathlon (Mixed). In addition a trophies are awarded to the highest scoring team and highest scoring individuals (Male and Female) in the Student Pentathlon (even if ineligible for the BUSA championships).
