## Competition Mobile

## The Rules

The competition shall be run in accordance with the 2007 UIPM Modern Pentathlon Rule book with MPAGB amendments, and additional rules dictating the scoring of the BUSA Pentathlon. This document is not in anyway to be considered a rule book for the competition.

## Jury of Appeal:

In the case of an appeal the jury shall be, Mr Ben Measures, Mr Jamie Frith joined by the OIC of the relevant event. The jury will hear reasonable argument and then shall make a fair decision according to the rules. The jury's decision is final.

## Team Rules

Pentathlon teams consist of three athletes of either sex each of whom must contest four events. Should an athlete not start all four events for any reason, the team will not be eligible. In addition, each of the five events must be contested by at least one member of the team. The team score is the sum of the best four scores of each individual regardless of the events in which those scores were obtained. Biathlon teams consist of three athletes of the same sex: the team score is calculated as the total of the three individual scores. No team changes can take place after the beginning of the first phase of competition.

Those completing a 'fence-tetrathlon' are entered into the pentathlon competition with no ride score.

## Further Information:

### Ride:

The ride will be a show jumping course (90cm/ 3ft) on an unfamiliar horse allocated by ballot. You will have 15mins on your horse in the collecting arena, during which time you may make no more than 4 practice jumps. You must make sure you jump in the correct direction.

### Fence:

Depending on numbers, the men's and women's fence may each be split into two seeded pools. Pool lists will be published during the respective warm ups on Saturday in the Sports Centre.

### Shoot:

Please arrive promptly to report to gun control at least 10minutes before you are due to shoot. Ladies in the first detail must make sure to arrive promptly on Saturday morning.

### Run:

3 laps of a 1000m course in University Parks.

### Swim heats:

8 lengths of a 25m pool.

The swim heats in the program as accurate as of 4th March. There may be alterations so please check your heat on the heat lists poolside.

BUSA Medals are awarded to the top three individuals in the Pentathlon and Biathlon (Male and Female), and the top three teams in the Biathlon (Male and Female) and the Pentathlon (Mixed). BUSA medals can only be awarded to members of Universities; alternative medals will be awarded to 6th formers. In addition trophies are awarded to the highest scoring teams.

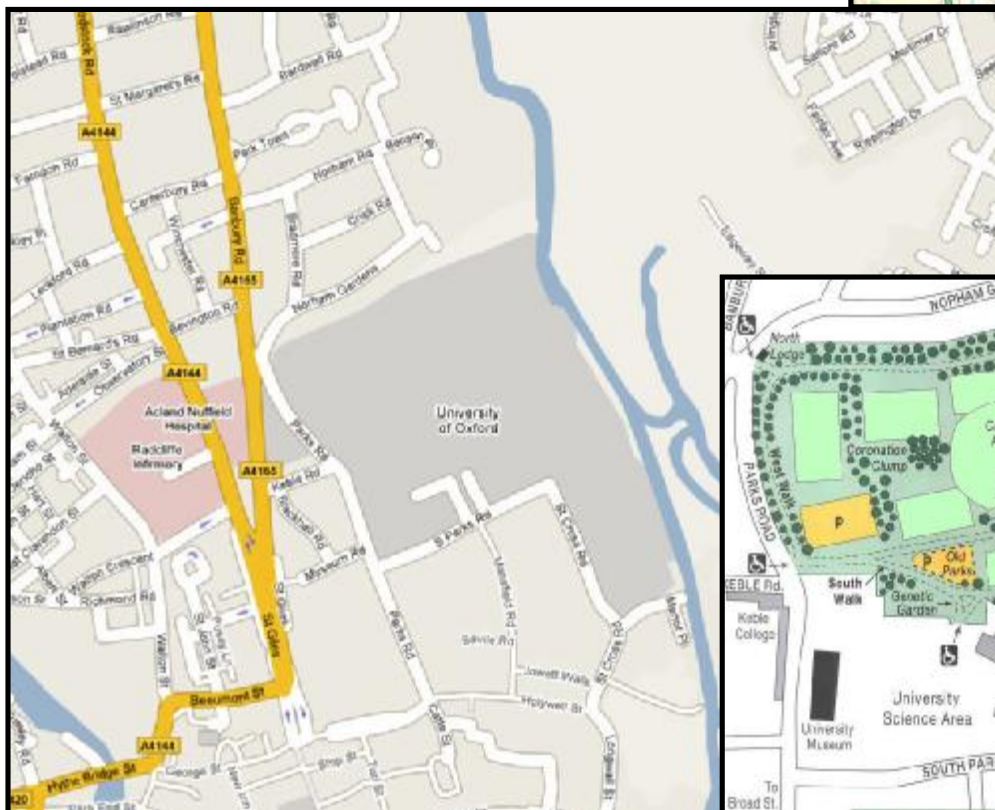
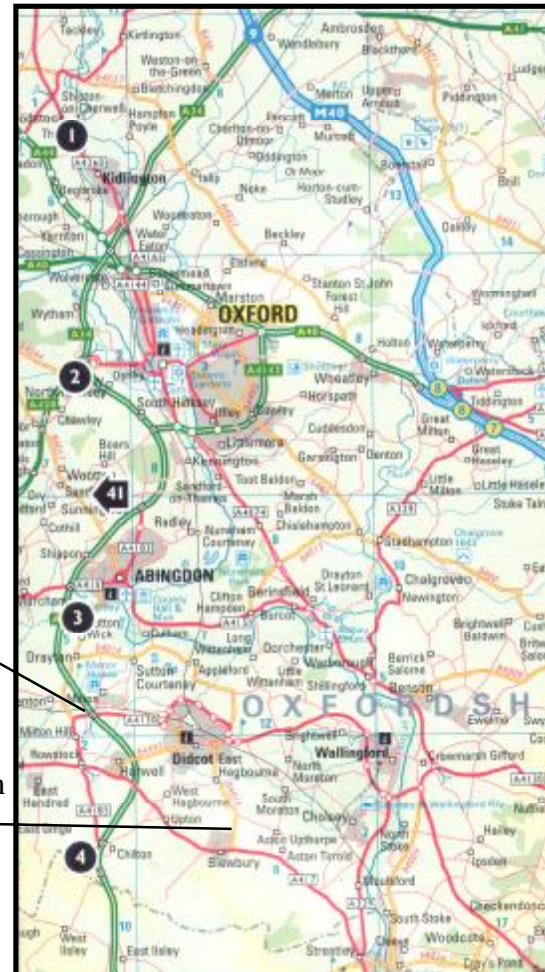
## Maps and Directions to Venues

### Getting to the events:

**Ride** – Blewbury Riding Centre (Friday, 7th March PM)  
 The ride is out of town, head south out of Oxford on the A30 and turn west on to the A4130 (going under the A30) towards Wantage. At the round-about where the road meets the A417 you turn left, east towards Harwell and Blewbury. Passing back over the A30 you go past the village of Upton and then through Blewbury and turn left after the service station at the end of the village on to the B 4016 towards Didcot. Blewbury riding centre is about half a mile down on the left hand side. Please turn up on time! There will only be one opportunity to walk the course at the beginning of the competition. There will be around 50 riders, so please be patient if you have to wait until a later round.

**Shoot and Fence** – Iffley Road Gym (Saturday, 8th March AM)  
 The gym is best approached from Jackdaw Lane off Iffley Road (A4158). Jackdaw Lane is on your right immediately before Greyfriars College as you go up Iffley Road from Magdalen round-a-bout (which is at the Oxford end of St Clement's Rbt Street, Cowley Road and Iffley Road). The fence will take place in the main Sports Hall, the shoot in the Cricket Schools at the same complex.

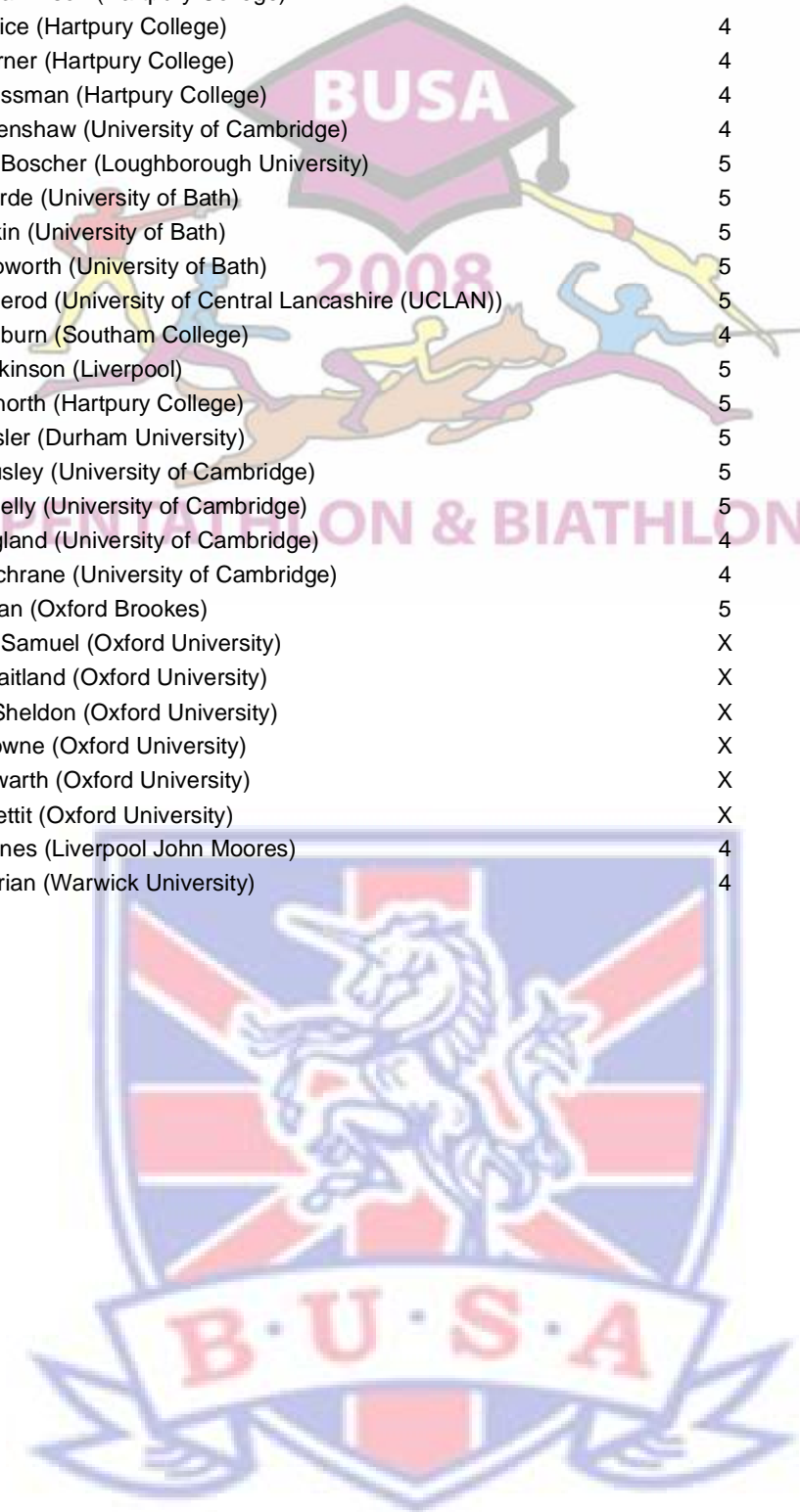
**Run** – University Parks (Saturday 8th March PM)  
 A new location for the run. University Parks is central so please car share if possible as parking is limited and subject to pay and display (Norham Gardens or Keble Road). From the sports centre head into town across Magdalen Roudabout up



towards the high street. Turn right into Longwall Street and follow this to the end as it snakes around the science buildings. Turn right into Parks Road and continue past the University Museum. The parks are then next on the right.

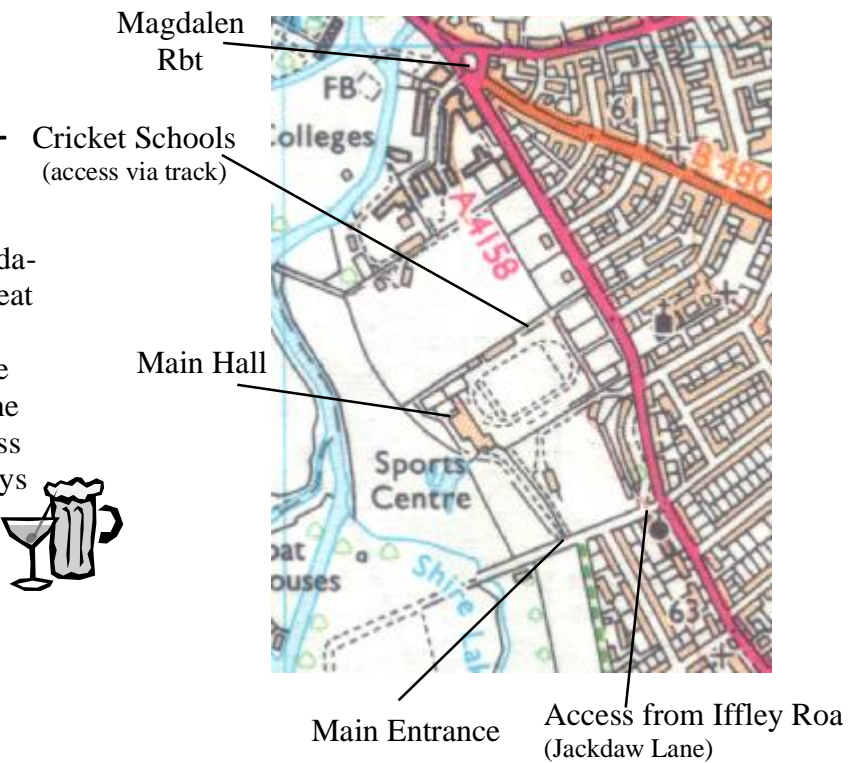

## Things to remember!!

It's always great that the BUSA pentathlon attracts many people to have a go at what is a rather complex sport. Here are a few hint to help the weekend run smoothly:

In in doubt, ask. There are lots of experienced athletes at the event who will be more than happy to lend some advise; take advantage. This goes for other sources of information too, if someone from the stables helps you get your horse try asking them what it's like to ride.

Be prepared; have your kit organised and ready, ensure you know where your horse is well before you need to present to the collecting ring (and do this on time to maximise your warm up). Your personal equipment is your responsibility; ensure your epees are well prepped, your goggles don't leak and your shoes are light and comfortable. Ensure that all your equipment is to modern safety standards; you will not be allowed to compete otherwise as it puts yourself and others at risk.

Be patient; the results for this competition are complex and need to be checked after everyone has finished, if you swim early this may feel like a bit of a wait. We'll endeavour to get you on your way as quickly as possible.

Stay for Saturday night, pentathlon is more than just five events... Don't go home until you've completed all seven...
